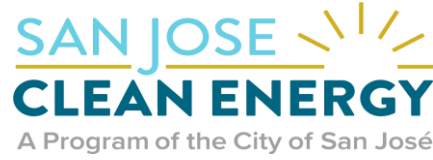

- DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME ADJUSTMENT: The time periods shown above will begin and end one hour later for the period between the second Sunday in March and the first Sunday in April, and for the period between the last Sunday in October and the first Sunday in November.

- HOLIDAYS: Holidays, for the purpose of this rate schedule, are New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. The dates will be those in which the holidays are legally observed.

## San José Clean Energy TotalGreen Commercial Rates

### TotalGreen Premium

Customers electing the TotalGreen 100% renewable energy service option will pay the applicable rate TotalGreen premium.

All usage – Small Commercial (A1, A6, and A15), Industrial (E20) and Other (e.g., SL-1, TC-1)	as above plus \$0.01/kWh
All usage – Medium Commercial (A10) and Large Commercial (E19)	as above plus \$0.005/kWh
